SALES FOR THE FIRST NINE MONTHS APPOINTMENT OF A NEW CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Colmar, 9th September2024 – Sales for the first nine months of the 2023/2024 financial year, down very slightly by 0.15% on the same period last year, came to €115.4m, compared with €115.6m in 2023.

THIRD QUARTER IN LINE WITH EXPECTATIONS

Sales for the third quarter (April to June 2024) rose by 1.4% to €39.5m, confirming a slight upturn in confidence among the Group's customers.

Good resilience for the Group over the first 9 months

Sales for the first nine months of the year, down by 0.15%, indicate a gradual return to more stable activity, despite the extraordinary weather conditions and the persistently difficult economic environment.

In terms of products, young plants and seeds are developing in the same way, with young plants accounting for 62% of sales and seeds 35%.

Business outlook for the end of the financial year

On the basis of available data, the fourth-quarter business, which represents an average of 13% of annual sales, confirms the stability of business over the full 2023/2024 financial year.

APPOINTMENT OF A NEW CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

Graines Voltz announces the appointment of Hugo Bony as Chief Executive Officer of the company. I am convinced that he will be able to preserve the Graines Voltz heritage, which I have built up over all these years with the exceptional support of my colleagues, while at the same time injecting a new dynamic. As Chairman of the Board of Directors, I will continue to support the company and work closely with Hugo to ensure the continuity of our mission," says Serge Voltz.
